

Application

- Apply via UCAS.
- Interviews required.
- Preparatory year option available (progression if ≥70% in all modules + DBS/health checks).



Personal Statement

Considered an important part of the application.

Should demonstrate:

- Strong motivation to study Pharmacy.
- Genuine interest in science and healthcare.
- Evidence of teamwork, communication, and professionalism.



• Compulsory for all applicants.

Used to confirm:

- Scientific knowledge (esp. Chemistry).
- Professional values & suitability for pharmacy practice.
- Communication and problem-solving abilities.
- Also required for progression from the Preparatory Year into Year 1 (alongside grade thresholds).



Entry Requirements

- A-Levels: BBB-AAB (must include Chemistry at B + another science).
- BTEC: DDM-DDD in Applied Science plus A-Level Chemistry (B).
- Access to HE (Science): + A-Level Chemistry (B).
- IB: 32 points incl. HL Chemistry + another science/Maths.
- GCSEs: English & Maths grade 4/C or above.



1 Other Requirements

- Interview part of selection.
- DBS & health checks needed.
- Ongoing Fitness to Practise declarations.
- GPhC-accredited course.
