Your application guide for applying to University of Greenwich and University of Kent joint course (Medway).

Application

- Apply via UCAS
- All shortlisted applicants must complete an interview (face-to-face; online option if can't attend) with standardised questions.

Personal Statement

- Show motivation to study Pharmacy and understanding of the profession.
- Highlight relevant skills: communication, empathy, teamwork, professionalism.
- Include experience if possible
- Used to help differentiate applicants who meet academic entry requirements

Interview Format

Assesses:

- Chemistry & maths knowledge.
- Professionalism & ethics.
- Communication & judgement in scenarios.
- Motivation for Pharmacy & Medway.

Sample Tasks:

- Ethical dilemmas (e.g. prescription errors, patient safety).
- Basic chemistry/science questions.
- "Why Pharmacy / why Medway?" type questions.

Other Requirements

- Criminal records / DBS check (Enhanced Disclosure) required.
- Health / Occupational Health clearance required.



Entry Requirements

- A-Levels: ABB (must include Chemistry + another science).
- BTEC Applied Science: DDD, or DDD + AS-Chemistry (grade B).
- IB: ~32 points (HL Chemistry + another science).
- GCSEs: English & Maths grade 5/B or above.
- Contextual offers may be lower but still require Chemistry + science.
